Located on Tsuut'ina land in Calgary, Alberta, this site is part of the Taza Park Project, an ambitious development by Taza Development Corp. This project is one of the largest First Nations developments in North America, aiming to urbanize 12,000 acres (about twice the area of JFK Airport) while delivering significant social and economic benefits to the Tsuut'ina Nation and the City of Calgary. Featuring geometric canopies reminiscent of a cabin and a harmonious blend of natural elements, the store's architecture exudes a cozy, comfortable feel. The design behind Tsuut'ina Gas logo is deeply rooted in the cultural symbolism of the buffalo, representing the provision of resources and employment for the Tsuut'ina people. The Tsuut'ina Gas Bar C-Store offers a range of locally sourced Indigenous products, including Mitsoh dried goods and Nu Trendz Signature Collection, alongside next-generation pizza brand Red Seal, and the first DFS Anthem UX dispensers in Canada.
